

# Big Poules

Engarde allows, except in Mini mode, to **make large size poules**. It is possible to make poules of 15, 20 and even 40 or 60.

A general algorithm provides an order of the matches for any size poules.  
For poules less than 9, the order of the matches of the FIE is used.

Engarde allows, except in Mini mode, to **play poules on multiple pistes**, in this case, Engarde provides an order of the matches for each poules using the general algorithm.

To make large size poules, simply select the desired number of poules.

To play poules on several pistes, you must go to the main parameters of the formula and give the value "yes" to "Some poules on several pistes."

In this case, during the creation of the poules, Engarde asks if you want to use multiple pistes for each size of poule used (from 6). It is possible to make poules of 9 on two pistes and poules of 10 on three pistes.

You can change the number of pistes assigned to a poule with "Modify the poules": when closing a poule, Engarde asks how many pistes it uses.

**To assign pistes to poules**, use the "Pistes | input pistes" menu and provide the names of the pistes separated by &, for example:

blue&red  
1&2&3

When a poule plays on several pistes, there is a poule sheet for each piste with the order of the matches that is used on the piste. If the pistes are close, it is preferable to fill in a single grid because it facilitates the entry on the computer.
